We will be departing the Moss Springs Trailhead at noon the 20th for a gentle, scenic 8 1/2 mile ride into the lodge. After a warm breakfast on the 26th, we will all be packing out together.

Cost is \$1500.00 per person for 5 complete days. Three square meals, lodging\* and showers are included. You may bring your own riding and pack stock; or for an additional fee, horses are available to ride during your adventure. For those choosing to fly in, the Minum Lodge does support an airstrip for an additional fee. If you have your own plane, just fly in!!

\*We have a **limited number of cabins**, complete with private bathrooms and showers. Also available is a dorm area located within the main lodge, and two teepees.
